

SPEAKERS



HON CLAY GLENNFORD SWEETING, MP Minister of Works & Family Island Affairs

A native of Spanish Wells, Eleuthera, Clay Sweeting was appointed to the Cabinet of The Bahamas Parliament following the general elections of September 2021. It has been noted that he can relate to the concerns and challenges of Family Islanders, given his lifelong residence and business ventures in the Eleuthera group.

Minister Sweeting brings a wealth of public service and business acumen to his Cabinet role. A former fisherman, his entrepreneurial spirit drove him to acquire a fifty-percent stake in a fishing vessel at the age of 17 and own Tees R Us Bahamas Ltd and other businesses. He previously served as the Chairman of the Spanish Wells Commonage Committee from 2008 to 2009 and is a member of the Bahamas Real Estate Association (BREA). In 2008, he ran for the Spanish Wells Local Government Elections, won, and became the youngest member to serve in Local Government at that time. He also served as the Deputy Chairman of the Bahamas Agricultural and Industrial Corporation, where he played an instrumental role in assisting and developing entrepreneurs and agriculture in the Bahamas. Under the former administration, Mr Sweeting represented the Opposition in the Senate.

Clay Sweeting received his early education at Spanish Wells All Age School, where he graduated as Valedictorian, followed by his tertiary education at Teeside University, UK.

Sweeting is married to Delia, and they are the proud parents of Darvin. He enjoys sports, fishing, traveling, and spending time with his family.



EMMANUEL C ALEXIOU Owner Abaco Beach Resort

Emmanuel C Alexiou is a Bahamian entrepreneur. His passion for improving The Bahamas for future generations is at the heart of everything he does, particularly through his stewardship of the Abaco Beach Resort and his ongoing contributions to development throughout the archipelago.

Alexiou's journey began at Queen's College, where he graduated in 1965, followed by studies in pre-dentistry at the University of Maryland. After a year and a half, he shifted his focus and transferred to Carleton University in Ottawa, Canada, where he earned a Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering in 1974.

Upon returning to The Bahamas, Alexiou worked for Cavalier Construction Company Limited and the New Providence Development Company before launching his own firm, Sunco Builders and Developers Limited, in 1977. Under his leadership, Sunco Builders became a major player in the construction industry, completing diverse projects on New Providence, including the Prince George Shopping Center, Charbray Plaza, renovations to Solomons buildings and the Barclays Bank building. His work also extended to major commercial and residential developments, including Westwind 1 and 2, Goodman's Bay Corporate Center and Caves Shopping Center.

In 1993, Alexiou made a milestone investment when he acquired the Abaco Beach Resort and Marina. Under his leadership, the resort expanded to offer 95 rooms and a 200-slip marina. He also led the rebuilding efforts after both Hurricane Floyd and Hurricane Dorian, and developed a 66-lot subdivision, The Great Abaco Club, complete with canals, docks and sea walls.

Alexiou's impact extends to other Family Islands. Sunco Builders was responsible for the construction of a 300-room Club Med Resort in San Salvador, along with a dive center and docks. On Bell Island in the Exumas, his company built homes, accompanied by a fitness center and essential infrastructure like staff quarters and seaplane docks. His business acumen is reflected in nationwide investments, including Hillside Plaza in Nassau, the Caraway office building in Freeport, and future developments on his land holdings in San Salvador.

Alexiou's influence is evident through leadership roles in several key organizations. He served as Director, Vice President, and later President of the Bahama Out Island Promotion Board; Vice President of the Bahamas Marinas Association; Director, then Vice President, of the Bahamas Hotel and Tourism Association and Director of the Bahamas Hospital Authority. He was also Director of the Airport Authority and the Nassau Airport Development Company (NAD), where he was head of the Capital Committee overseeing major expansions at the Lynden Pindling International Airport (LPIA).

Outside of professional achievements, Alexiou enjoys reading,

boating, sailing, skiing both on land and snow, playing squash, exercising, and listening to music.
